

Riding in The Kingdom of Orpheus (Western Rhodopes Mountain)



4 days, 3 nights, 1 day riding

The mythical Rhodopes mountain will let you be absorbed in the enchanting world of Orpheus, where you will discover the dramatic and majestic beauty of nature. You will travel back in time to the ancient Bulgarian roots revealing impressive towering Thracian sacred places. In this adventure you will be accompanied by our ancestors' sacred animals – horses. You will have the rare chance to feel the spirit of Bulgarian tradition, customs and culture while visiting authentic villages, nestling churches and mosques, becoming a part of this cosmopolitan world in an attempt to reveal the secrets of the mystical Rhodopes mountain.

Itinerary highlights:

- Visiting natural phenomena
- Contact with local people and culture
- A wide range of scenery
- Becoming familiar with Bulgarian tradition and spirit

About the horses:

Our horses are an excellent and extremely well selected group of breeds perfectly suitable for the riding terrain. Breeds include Shagya, Arabian and Eastern Bulgarian horses. They are friendly and well trained. Height varies between 1,50 and 1,60 metres. The saddles are Cavalry and Western type. The weight limit for the riders is 100kg.

Itinerary description Day-By-Day:

Day 1: Sofia - Trigrad

Accommodation: Hotel

Arrival in the village of Trigrad. On the way to the village you will ride through the famous Trigrad gorge long 7km and 250m of cliffs. Accommodation in a two-star hotel located in a walking distance from our stables. Meet your guides and the horses.

Day 2: Trigrad – Vodnepad

Ride 2 hours

Accommodation: Hotel

After breakfast you mount your horse and head to the village of Vodnepad. Ride along the winding gorge of the Vodnipadska River full of cascades. You reach the ancient Rhodopean village of Vodnepad, located on the border with Greece. Returning back to the village of Trigrad using the same route.

Day 3: Trigrad

Accommodation: Hotel

Free time for hiking, cave exploration (spelunking), ATV, motor or bicycle riding, fishing, photography, bird watching, and other entertainment offered by local entrepreneurs and facilities.

Day 4: Trigrad – Sofia (Airport)

After breakfast – say goodbye to the guides and the horses. Departure from Trigrad to Sofia Airport.

If your departure flight is scheduled around or later than 17.00h on the departure day, we offer a visit to the Bachkovo Monastery „Uspenye Bogorodychno“ - the second biggest monastery in Bulgaria. It is rising like an impressive Medieval castle in the picturesque valley of the Chaya River surrounded by high rocky and wooded mountains. There is also an optional visit and lunch at the Old Town of Plovdiv.

Note – ArkanTours reserves the right to change the day's itinerary due to circumstances beyond our control such as fallen trees, landslides or landslips caused by torrential rains, newly fenced off areas, and acts of God creating unexpected obstacles on the road.

Required Riding Levels and Skills

Required experience – It is necessary that the rider feels comfortable on the horse at the two basic riding paces (Walk, Trot) and not to lose control riding thru mild terrain.

Horses are good-tempered and suited for the mountain terrain, they are brave and easily get over natural obstacles on the way (rivers, small gullies, fallen trees). They are not afraid of cars and ride with ease on busy roads and urban areas.

Rider's involvement – Riders are expected to groom and tack up their own horse each day in preparation for rides, untack during the breaks and at the end of the day. Off course, this will be performed under the kind supervision and help from our guides.

Riding days – 1 day

Riding hours a day – 2 hours

Paces: Walking and some trot

Itinerary characteristics

Terrain – Mellow mountain terrain.

Climate – Temperate continental, cool nights at higher regions, warm summer days. There is possibility of frequent and occasional rains in the spring-summer period.

Accommodation – Two-star hotel

Distance from urban areas – During the ride the furthest point is 8 km away from urban areas. There are scattered small mountain villages and hamlets and more rarely bigger towns.

Cross-cultural awareness - The regions that we pass have mixed population with Christian and Islamic religion, living peacefully with each other. Let us show respect and tolerance for different cultures ways of life and traditions.
